Quando esté en un lugar público, use una cubierta de tela para la cara sobre su nariz y boca.



Evite tocarse los ojos, la nariz y la boca.



Limpie y desinfecte los objetos y superficies que se tocan con frecuencia.



Quédese en casa cuando esté enfermo, excepto para recibir atención médica.



Lávese las manos frecuentemente con agua y jabón por al menos 20 segundos.

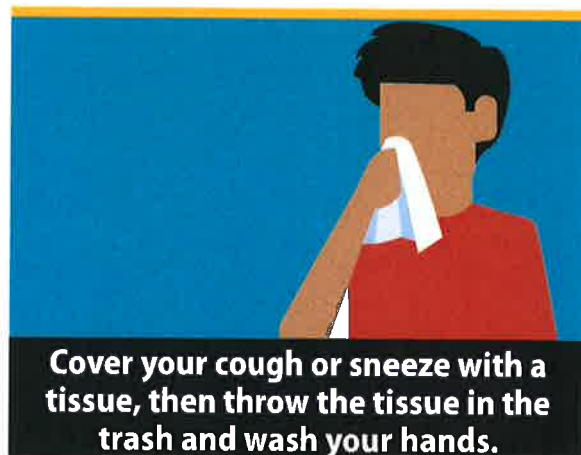


## Wash Your Hands

Wash your hands often with soap and water for at least 20 seconds, or use an alcohol based hand sanitizer that contains at least 60% alcohol.



## Wear Your Covering

Wear a mask that covers your nose and mouth when in the office. Avoid touching your eyes, nose, and mouth.



## Maintain Social Distancing

Keep 6 feet of distance between you and others whenever possible.

Frequently clean and disinfect high touch surfaces such as counters, phones, computer equipment, workstations, tables, switches, handles, etc.

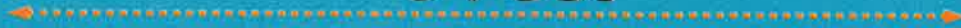

## 3 REQUIREMENTS FOR ENTERING

### 1. ANSWER AND PASS SCREENING QUESTIONS

**Use your phone to answer these questions by scanning the QR code or visiting [tn.gov/screening](https://tn.gov/screening).**

*Electronic results are good for up to 12 hours when entering state buildings.*

1. Have you been in close contact with a confirmed case of COVID-19 within the last 14 days?

2. Are you experiencing any of the following?

*Cough, Shortness of Breath or Sore Throat*

3. Have you had a fever in the last 48 hours?

4. Have you had a new loss of taste or smell?

5. Have you had vomiting or diarrhea in the last 24 hours?
